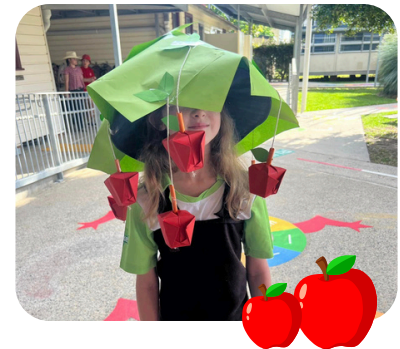

What is happening in the 3/4 Classroom

Last week, our 3/4 class went on their excursion to the Byron Bay Wildlife Sanctuary. The students were buzzing with excitement as we arrived and learned about the world of wildlife conservation.

At the sanctuary, the kids learned about various habitats, the threats they face, and ways we can contribute to their preservation. The highlight of the day was coming face-to-face with a blue-tongued lizard, a spotted python, and a black-red-tailed cockatoo. The students also enjoyed exploring the sanctuary and attending a lively free-flight bird show, where they encountered some delightfully cheeky birds.

Feeding the goats turned out to be the crowning moment of the day, with many students sharing that it was their favourite part of the trip. It was a fantastic experience that sparked curiosity and a deeper appreciation for wildlife conservation among our students.

In addition to our exciting excursion, our 3/4 class has been immersing themselves in the world of Australian author Emily Rodda's Rowan of Rin. The students have been thoroughly enjoying the thrilling adventures of Rowan and

his friends, and it's been wonderful to see their enthusiasm for the story. We've been exploring how Rodda crafts her characters and the ways she builds their journeys. They are now channelling their creativity into writing their own stories, applying the techniques they've learned from Rodda's engaging characters and plot twists. It's been a fantastic way for them to connect with literature and express their imagination!

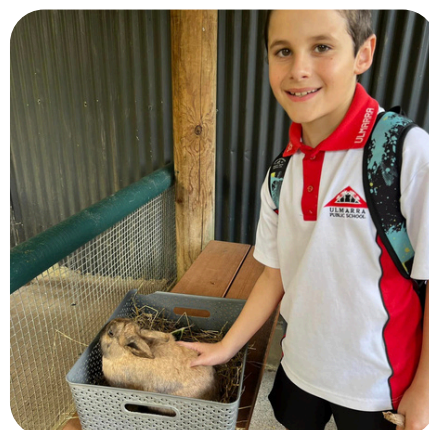
